But we were particularly inspired by the former Jamestown Brewing Company which opened in 1897. Unfortunately, it went defunct as a result of National Prohibition in 1920. • As it was nearly 90 years ago, our version of Chautauqua Brew contains only the finest ingredients and is warranted strictly pure. We brew this golden session ale as a compliment to life in the Southern Tier.
